Wesley Daniel called the Selectmen's Meeting to order at 7:00 p.m.

Road Foreman Report: Written by Frank Jones, Jr. and read by Wesley Daniel:

1/25/2021: 6:30am-4:30pm- patched pot holes on Dorman, Skidmore and Sprague Roads; Greg was sent home for COVID-19 test.

1/26/2021: 6:30am-4:30pm & 9pm-12am- Steven and Frank patch pot holes on old County Road; called out to plow at 9pm; Frank called in Steven, Troy and Jason to help.

1/27/2021: 12:00am-3:00pm- Plowed and sanded; Jason left at 8:30 and Troy left at 10:30am.

1/28/2021: 6:30am-4:30pm- Steven and Frank looked for the oil leak in P-500; Put new cutting edge on wing; made a new wing arm for P-100; put in salt.

1/29/2021: 9:30am-4:30pm- Steven and Frank plowed and sanded-Troy and Jason could not leave work.

CEO Report: Corey Fortin, the new Assistant CEO stated that he has begun the certification process.

Health Officer Report: None.

Town Clerk/Treasurer's Report: Mary Anderson stated that the bank balance is \$537,348.84; The new sneeze guard protectors were received; The town office was closed on Tuesday for a snow day; We are ready for the audit, which will be tomorrow.

Other Agenda Items:

-December Bank Statement: the Selectmen signed the December bank statement as presented.

-There are still no Union Ambulance or Tri-County Waste Management numbers yet.

-Wesley Daniel suggested that we take care of the tree in Maple Grove Cemetery that was only partially taken care of last year. It will need to be added to the budget.

-The Selectmen discussed a 3% pay raise for the plow truck drivers. They are currently at \$16.50 an hour and this would raise their wage to \$17 an hour. Tom recommended waiting to raise the wage until after the town meeting and give it to them retroactively as a bonus.

-Charlotte Henderson –The Alewives Committee Liaison: Charlotte stated that the Alewives project has received unanimous support from the Washington Lakes Association. She received an opinion from a specialist that the fish ladder will not be detrimental to the water level of Washington pond. Charlotte asked the Selectmen if they knew where the ownership of the Washington Pond dam is located. Tom responded that it is recorded on the Cavanaugh deed and under the Maine Church of the Nazarene.
