



Selectmen's /Assessors Meeting Summary

July 21, 2021

7:00 P.M.

Selectmen Present: Wesley Daniel, Tom Johnston. Mitch Garnett.

Others Present: Mary Anderson-Town Clerk, Corey Fortin-CEO, David Williams, Donald Grinnell, Peg Hobbs

Wesley Daniel called the Selectmen's Meeting to order at 7:00 p.m.

Approve Summary of July 14, 2021: Motion to approve summary by Tom Johnston, Mitch Garnett 2nd, All in favor, Motion's carried.

Road Foreman Report: Written by Frank Jones, Jr. and read by Wesley Daniel:

7/12/2021: 6:30am to 4:30pm- Moved stone and gravel so Pidacks could set up crusher; P200 will not start, Frank called Travis Kilbreth to look at truck.

7/13/2021: 6:30am to 4:30pm- Travis Kilbreth looked at P200 and found a broken wire; Ditched on Prescott Road.

7/14/2021: 6:30am to 4:30pm- Frank went for a mandatory drug test; Cut brush and ditched on Prescott.

7/15/2021: 6:30am to 4:30pm- Replaced 2 culverts on Prescott Road- 1 was 8x30 and 1 was 8x40; ditched; Pidacks is over half done.

CEO Report: Corey Fortin stated that he made a site visit to Windy Hill Lane to answer some shore land questions; Performed a final septic inspection at 460 Waldoboro Road; Corey drove around checking on the progress of ongoing projects.

Health Officer Report: None

Town Clerk/Treasurer's Report: Mary Anderson stated that we received a Revenue Share check of \$20,666.31 and a Homestead Exemption Reimbursement check for \$39,529; The Bank Balance is \$141,127.98; Kit Lascoux will post the Special Town Meeting; The Broadband Committee is going to pass out flyers for the Town Meeting during the Community Yard Sale; Mary is taking Friday off.

Other Agenda Items:

Marr Cemetery Deed: The Selectmen signed a deed for Lot 346 in Marr Cemetery.

Real Estate Tax Abatement: The Selectmen received a request for an abatement on Map 2-Lot 14C and a supplemental bill will be sent out for \$366 to map 2-Lot 14D. They will offset each other. Wesley Daniel made a motion to approve the abatement, Tom Johnston 2nd, All in favor, Motion passed.

Special Town Meeting Warrant: The Special Town Meeting is going to take place at 7pm at the Fire Station on August 4, 2021. Tom made a motion to sign the Warrant, Mitch 2nd, All in favor, Motion passed.

MMA Annual Vote for Officers: Wesley Daniel asked if any of the Selectmen wanted to vote. The Selectmen declined.

TCSWMO Appointment: Wesley Daniel made a motion to appoint Lee A Shane to the TCSWMO Committee as an alternate. Tom Johnston 2nd, All in Favor, Motion carried.

Questions and Comments:

Donald Grinnell: Don stated that the intern who is doing the culvert survey in Union is almost ready to begin in Washington. Washington would not have to pay the intern for his time but Union did pay for his mileage. Don wanted to check in with the Selectmen to see if they would be willing to do the same. Don recommended reaching out to Jay Fyller to discuss the project. Wesley Daniel stated that he would call Jay on Friday.

Peg Hobbs: Peg asked about the big trucks that are pulling water out of Washington Pond. She stated that when they come in, they take up the whole parking lot. Wesley Daniel stated that the Town does not own the pond, the state does. There was a brief conversation regarding the number of trucks that take water from the pond and the amount of water that is taken.
