



## Selectmen's /Assessors Meeting Summary

July 28, 2021

**Selectmen Present:** Wesley Daniel, Tom Johnston. Mitch Garnett.

**Others Present:** Mary Anderson-Town Clerk, Corey Fortin-CEO

Wesley Daniel called the Selectmen's Meeting to order at 7:00 p.m.

**Approve Summary of July 21, 2021:** Motion to approve summary by Tom Johnston, Mitch Garnett 2<sup>nd</sup>, All in favor, Motion's carried.

**Road Foreman Report:** Written by Frank Jones, Jr. and read by Wesley Daniel:

7/19/2021: 6:30am to 5:30pm- Frank marked Calderwood Rd for ditching Dig Sfe #20212900439; Frank marked Youngs Hill Rd for 2 culverts to clean out ends; Ditched on Prescott Rd; Frank met with Vaughn from Hagar to look at Youngs Hill Rd, he said to keep an eye on it and look for water puddles.

7/20/2021: 6:30am to 4:30pm- Cut trees and ditched on Prescott Rd.

7/21/2021: 6:30am to 5:00pm- Ditched and cut brush on Prescott Rd; Called to move tree from Maple Grove Cemetery. 1:00pm to 4:30pm; Went back to Prescott Rd to fill in hole.

7/22/2021: 6:00am to 4:30pm- Called out for down trees on Mountain, Skidmore and Old County Roads; Ditched on Prescott.

**CEO Report:** Corey Fortin stated that he issued a permit and inspected a septic at Andrew Lee's property; Wrote a letter to Armstrong about his sign and sent a 2<sup>nd</sup> letter to the house on Rt. 17 regarding the trash and septic issue giving them 10 days; Inspected Jake Barbour's pit; Inspected Geo Engineering septic system; Checked on various projects around town and is waiting for Peter Drum, the town's attorney, to respond in response to a question about the definition of a home occupation. Mitch Garnett asked about any notification regarding the property on Prescott Road but no one has heard anything.

**Health Officer Report:** None

**Town Clerk/Treasurer's Report:** Mary Anderson stated that the bank balance is \$211,239.14; Joan Tognacci (formerly Hayward) has given her notice of resignation as Deputy Clerk/Deputy Treasurer and August 20 will be her last day. She would like to stay on as Selectmen's Secretary and Registrar of Voters. Mary stated that she would like to put an ad in the Courier, MMA website, our website and the list serve; The streetlights were switched to LED yesterday by CMP; Intern, Mike Levesque is going to map out and take pictures of the street culverts in Washington that will be

available on-line; We have received an updated, signed paperwork and audit from RSU40; Lynn Carrol is going to come in on Friday to install the anti-virus software on the computers.

**Other Agenda Items:**

**Plow Truck Price:** Wesley Daniel stated that he would like to put a price on the plow truck that is for sale. The Selectmen agreed to a price of \$12,500. They will let any previously interested parties know what the price is.

**Special Town meeting:** The Special Town Meeting will take place in the Fire Station at 7pm and the Selectmen's Meeting will be at 6pm. The trucks will be moved out and the podium will need to be brought over. Mary Anderson asked if the Pledge of Allegiance is going to be said before the meeting and the Selectmen said yes. Mary responded that she would check in with Phil Meunier to see if he was planning on attending.
