Wesley Daniel called the Selectmen's Meeting to order at 7:00 p.m.

Road Foreman Report: Written by Frank Jones, Jr. and read by Wesley Daniel:

5/3/2021: 6:30am to 4:30pm- Steven worked in shop, power washed P-500; Frank took sick day.

5/4/2021: 6:30am to 4:30pm- Ditched Youngs Hill Road before paving and unplugged culvert on Youngs Hill and Skidmore Roads.

5/5/2021: 6:00am to 4:30pm- Took culvert to McDowell Road and unplugged culverts; Frank called for a windshield for P-200; worked on P-200 brakes.

5/6/2021: 8:00am to 4:30pm- Went to get P-400 from HP Fairfield; Unplugged culvert on Skidmore.

CEO Report: Corey Fortin stated that he finished the pit letters and is verifying amounts; He's getting a list of active pits from DEP; He is working with Brian Alves, Health Officer, regarding a property on Augusta Road; Corey is working on two site plans and Finding of Facts; Did a site visit on Augusta Road to approve a new septic; Went to Bowman Mills Road and declined a variance request for a replacement septic because it was too close to the well; He is working with the owner of Maine Audio Visual to get his property up to code.

Health Officer Report: None.

Town Clerk/Treasurer's Report: Mary Anderson stated that she received a General Assistance Reimbursement from the State for \$146.23; The bank balance is \$153,626.08; Bill from Kofile came to pick up records for preservation; Lynn Carroll hooked up the new PC yesterday; There are Brown Tail Moths in the tree out front and the library is having someone come to look at them on Monday.

Other Agenda Items:

Town Grounds Gardens: Wesley Daniel stated that Denise Hylton, who usually works in the Community Garden at the Town Office, has hurt her back. We need to hire someone else to take care of the garden beds. Ray Gushee has offered to clean up and maintain them for \$500 for the season. Wesley Daniel Made a motion to hire Ray Gushee to maintain the Town Office Gardens for \$500, Tom Johnston 2nd, All in favor, Motion passed.

Public Hearing to update the GA Manual: The Selectmen will hold a public hearing for adoption of the updated General Assistance Ordinance which will begin at 7 p.m., followed by the regular agenda.

Assessor's Agent: It was agreed that the Town should post an opening for the Assessor's Agent on the Website, around town, on the MMA website and in the newspaper.

Interview Road Crew Applicants: Frank Jones Jr. has requested that the Selectmen interview Road Crew Candidates. The Selectmen agreed to interview one candidate at 6:15pm and the other at 6:30pm.

Ezra Casas Appointment Papers: Wesley Daniel made a motion to appoint Ezra Casas as an alternate to the Planning Board, Tom Johnston 2nd, All in Favor, Motion Passed. Steve Ocean will be the new Chairperson and Kate Grinnell will be the Co-chair and Secretary.
