



Selectmen's /Assessors Meeting Summary

May 26, 2021

Selectmen Present: Wesley Daniel, Tom Johnston. Mitch Garnett.

Others Present: Mary Anderson-Town Clerk, Corey Fortin-CEO, Traci Hoffman..

Wesley Daniel called the Selectmen's Meeting to order at 7:00 p.m.

Approve Summary of May 19, 2021: Motion to approve summary by Tom Johnston, Mitch Garnett 2nd, All in favor, Motion's carried.

Road Foreman Report: Written by Frank Jones, Jr. and read by Wesley Daniel:

5/17/2021: 6:30am to 5:00pm- Steven and Frank picked up the excavator from Eagle Rental; Started to ditch on McDowell Road-4 hrs; JR Glass came to put new windshield in P-100.

5/18/2021: 6:30am to 4:30pm- Ditched on McDowell Road, Called Chris to help flag.

5/19/2021: 6:00am to 4:30pm- Took down 2 trees at Town Office- 2 hrs; Trimmed cedar trees on Rt. 220 and 105- 1 hr; Back to ditching- 7 hrs.

5/20/2021: 6:00am to 4:30pm- Unplugged culvert on Skidmore Road- 2 hrs; Ditched McDowell – 8 hrs.

CEO Report: Corey Fortin stated that he mailed letters to the abutters for the Nelson Ridge Road project; Wrote a Public Hearing Notice and Mary Anderson posted them in the Kennebec Journal and Morning Sentinel and around town; Working on the Finding of Fact for 46 Nelson Ridge Road and updating the Finding of Fact template; Approved a septic plan for a replacement system on Route 220; Continuing work on the decommissioning plan for the Solar project. They mailed a check to us but they are aware that it's on hold for the time being; The Pit Inspection letters went out after Corey cross-referenced them with DEP mining list. There was discussion regarding the decommissioning fee.

Health Officer Report: Brian Alves was not present but Wesley Daniel stated that Brian is going to try to set up a Covid-19 vaccination clinic the day of the election. Regarding use of the Gibbs Library, Mary Anderson is going to contact Sarah Masters, the President of the Board, Kathy Ocean, the Vice President and Kate Nichols, the Library Manager to ask them if it is okay to use the library.

Town Clerk/Treasurer's Report: Mary Anderson stated that the bank balance is \$26,640.12; Kevin from Transco has offered to upgrade the printer for the same cost per month for the remainder of the current contract and once the current contract is up, the rate would be increased \$30 a month. Wesley Daniel made a motion to wait until the current contract is up to discuss upgrading the copier, Mitch Garnett 2nd, All in favor, Motion passed.

Other Agenda Items:

Appointments for Cemetery Committee: Wesley Daniel made a motion to appoint Jesse Casas and Sarah Collins to the Cemetery Committee, Tom Johnston 2nd, All in favor, Motion passed.

Appointment for School Board: Julia Abernathy has requested to be appointed to the School Board. Mitch Garnett made a motion to appoint Julia Abernathy to the School Board, Tom Johnston 2nd, All in favor, Motion passed.

Letter for Pre-Application Site Inspection at Washington Pond: The Selectmen signed a letter presented by the Washington Lakes Association to be sent to request a pre-application site visit in reference to the Grant application for the dock. Wesley Daniel made a motion to sign the letter, Mitch Garnett 2nd, All in favor, Motion passed.

Application for the Position of Assessor's Agent: The Selectmen received one application for the Assessor's Agent position. Wesley Daniel is going to call to check the applicant's references before bringing them in for an interview. The Selectmen would like Stanley Millay, the current Assessor's Agent, to be part of the interview process.

-Kit Lascoutx, Regarding a New Town Sign: Kit Lascoutx, Town Constable, has offered to pay up to \$500 for a town sign that could be used as a notification to the residents of the Town. He believes that it would be a benefit, especially for events such as the Vaccination Clinic. Mary Anderson is going to look into it.
