



**Select Board /Assessors Meeting Summary**

**Select Board members Present:** Wes Daniel, Tom Johnston and Mitch Garnett

**Others Present:** Town Clerk/Treasurer Mary Anderson, Road Foreman Frank Jones Jr., and Charlie Emerson from All States Construction Inc.

Wes Daniel called the meeting to order at 7 p.m.

**Approve Summary of May 11, 2022:** Tom corrected the date of the school budget vote to May 17 and the name of the public works truck replacement fund in the summary. Motion to approve summary, as amended, by Tom Johnston, Mitch Garnett seconded; all in favor, motion carries.

**Town Clerk/Treasurer's Report:** Town employees will meet with a representative from The First about the Simple IRA program Thursday at 10:30 a.m. Mary said the school budget passed at Tuesdays meeting. Absentee ballots for the June 14 election arrived on Monday. The checking account balance is \$42,874.

Wes said the town may need to borrow money next week. Tom asked if lien notices generated much money and Mary said a few people have been in to pay.

**Other Agenda Items:** Select Board members signed the April bank statement.

Five paving bids were received and Select Board members opened them. All States Construction bid a total of \$512,496.62; Pike Industries bid a total of \$446,555.20; Mainely Paving bid a total of \$484,107.66; NorthEast Paving bid a total of \$456,927; and FC Works and Son bid a total of \$572,039. All of the bids were higher than anticipated and Select Board members talked about options that would better fit the budgeted amount for paving. No vote was taken. Tom and Frank will reach out to the low bidder, Pike, about the town's budget.
