



Select Board /Assessors Meeting Summary

Aug. 24, 2022

Select Board members Present: Wes Daniel, Tom Johnston and Mitch Garnett

Others Present: Town Clerk/Treasurer Mary Anderson, resident David Williams

Wes Daniel called the Select Board meeting to order at 6:30 p.m.

Approve Summary of Aug. 17, 2022: Motion to approve summary by Tom Johnston, Mitch Garnett seconded; all in favor, motion carries.

Sign Treasurer's Warrants dated Aug. 25, 2022:

P/R Warrant #69: \$4,632.74

A/P Warrant #70: \$161,233.03 (includes county communications fee as well as payment for fire department air packs)

Motion to approve warrants by Tom Johnston, Mitch Garnett seconded; all in favor, motion carries.

Road Foreman Report: Written by Frank Jones Jr. and read by Wes Daniel

8/15: Replaced a 15-by-40 culvert and cleaned out the ditch on Prescott Road.

8/16: Moved the fill in the pit from winter sand; power washed the excavator before taking it back.

8/17: Moved 80 loads of winter sand, 417 loads remain.

8/18: David had a doctor's appointment; Steven and Frank worked in the shop picking up and putting things back after ditching.

CEO Report: None.

Health Officer Report: None

Town Clerk/Treasurer's Report: Town Clerk Mary Anderson reported the town received a Homestead Exemption reimbursement check of \$106,385; a General Assistance reimbursement check of \$369.87; and a Revenue Sharing check in the amount of \$18,852.09. Sarah Reynolds is working on becoming a notary. Frank and Mary met with Debbie from MMA to talk about problems with health insurance; Debbie also told them vision and dental can be offered by the town at no cost (employees bear the full cost). Tom made a motion to offer dental and vision to employees, Wes seconded; all in favor, motion passes.

Mary will speak with Kim Emerson from Axiom tomorrow about invoices.

Frank, Steven, David, Rick and Jason have all been signed up to a Nov. 1 workshop in Union about winter road maintenance.

Tom asked for a checking account balance. Mary said property tax payments are starting to come in so the account is looking better, but the town still needs to pay back \$150,000 borrowed from the line of credit and there are a number of large bills being paid this time of year, such as county communications, new air packs and the school district.

Other Agenda Items: Select Board members signed the July bank statement.

A public hearing was set for Wednesday, Sept. 7, at 7 p.m. for the closure of Lincoln Road to winter maintenance. The Select Board meeting will begin at 6:30 p.m. that evening.

Other business: Mary reached out to MMA regarding the town's unemployment insurance at Tom's request, but she has not yet heard back.

Mitch made a motion to adjourn, Tom seconded; all in favor. Meeting adjourned at 6:41 p.m.
