Wes Daniel called the Select Board meeting to order at 7:00 p.m.

Wes called the General Assistance Public Hearing to order at 7:00 p.m. No discussion regarding adopting the A-H Appendices for October 1, 2023 - September 30, 2024. Wes closed the public hearing at 7:03 p.m.

CEO Report: Mary and Stephanie helped reach out to the few pits that had not paid yet. Most of them have come in to pay; waiting on Jake Barbour and Pike. Corey did the Halls pit inspections today, everything looked good. Did a site visit at 13 Old Town House Rd. for some trees he wants to cut. Corey gave him the ok to cut 4 trees in the shoreland zone that were dying. Corey did a septic system inspection today. Got an email from the Welzel's; Corey knew they had started on their building permit. Corey stated on the other side of the pond the camp had DEP approval to do stabilization. Corey will reach out to the Welzel's to meet with them. Mitch asked when Corey gives permission to cut trees if

he keeps a log of where/why with pictures. He will write a letter for today's visit and put it in the file. Corey will make up a log for future knowledge and answer questions when someone calls. Wes asked Corey to check the house on Bill Luce Road that was condemned, Peter has on his docket. The person that had been living there is not there and will not return. The owner is supposed to demolish it.

Health Officer Report: None.

Town Clerk/Treasurer's Report: A Revenue Share check was received on 9/22 for \$22,575.37. Keith Reilly, Roads Committee, was looking for some feedback from the committee's report. Bank balance \$745,924.00. CCI & CMP haven't cashed the checks for make ready. The mortgage company checks came in from Core Logic on Monday – all in the system. Peter Drum will be at the October 25th meeting.

Wes stated that Pidacks will not do our crushing job next year. They have decided to stay and work from their pit in Livermore and not do smaller jobs throughout the state.

Wes stated that they have a request from the PTG to close Old Union Road for Trunk or Treat on Saturday, October 28th. Wes made the motion to close the road, Mitch seconded; all in favor. Wes spoke with the Fire Chief about traffic control and he said he'd take care of it.

Wes moved to adopt the General Assistance Appendices October 1, 2023 – September 30, 2024 A-H, Mitch seconded; all in favor.

Other business:

Kate stated Don Grinnell has nothing to report for EMA. For the Trails Committee we're going to have the Seven Tree football club do community service project on the trail scheduled for Sunday, October 15th. Kate will purchase safety gear (hearing protection, safety glasses and work gloves).
