Free Wood Chips and/or Firewood Recycling Program

Program Summary:

Through our Tree Pruning program, Weymouth Township generates wood material in the form of wood chips and unprocessed firewood. To simplify our operations, serve our residents, and recycle, we try to put this back into the community. We deliver both unprocessed firewood and wood chips free of charge.

The woodchips are ideal for home landscaping and the tree logs offer firewood for the winter months. The free wood chips and tree logs are available to Township residents only and are not available to landscapers or other private businesses.

Wood Chips:

Residents can call the Department of Public Works for free wood chips. The wood chips we have are rough and irregular compared to what you might purchase in bags from Home Depot or have delivered by a landscape company. There will be leaves, some sticks, and irregularly shaped chips mixed in. They are great for landscaping, mulching, and gardening, though! Each load of chips is approximately four cubic feet. That is enough to fill an area six feet by six feet by three feet high. Not all loads are this large, but we cannot guarantee anything smaller. The Public Works Department will deliver the wood chips on your driveway **only**, not on driveway aprons, sidewalks, or lawns.

Firewood:

Residents can call the Department of Public Works for free delivery. The wood delivery is not cut to length or split. It could be of any species of tree, although we will not deliver coniferous trees (pine/evergreen) without checking first, and can vary in length from 1-8' and diameter from 6-40". The size of wood loads varies greatly. It can be a half dozen 12"x3' logs or an entire large tree. If you do not want to receive a large load, please indicate this in the comments section. The Public Works Department will deliver the unprocessed firewood.

Delivery:

We will deliver free of charge to locations that are in Weymouth Township. There must be a hard flat surface at least 8'x10' for us to dump onto (i.e. driveway). We will not drive into backyards or across soft surfaces to dump.

The delivery of your wood chips will be coordinated and scheduled based on availability through Weymouth Township Department of Public Works. 609-476-2102 or PublicWorks@WeymouthNJ.org

We will contact you as far in advance as we can. Typically this is only a day or two; often it is shorter notice. Please include a form of contact that you can be reliably reached at. All efforts will be made to give the contact a call prior to delivery however, this cannot be guaranteed.

THE PROPERTY OWNER/RESIDENT AGREES TO THE FOLLOWING CONDITIONS:

1. Customer is a Township Resident and owns the property listed above. Renters must have the property owner sign the application.
2. Customer may not be contacted prior to delivery, and will designate a delivery location that is accessible to the delivery vehicles.
3. Customer will provide a street map to the service address, and a property diagram identifying the exact location where the load is to be delivered. (Space provided at bottom of page.)
4. Customer releases Weymouth Township and its contractors from any liability or cleanup resulting from or in connection to the delivery of firewood and wood chips.
5. Weymouth Township will deliver coarse wood chips, which may consist of varying combinations of wood, leaves and pine needles, to the above customer's address and delivery location free of charge. Weymouth Township notes that the wood chips are delivered as is, and are not landscape quality. Weymouth Township suggests that they be used as ground cover away from the house, for unpaved driveways, mulch piles, pathways, or parking areas.
6. Generally, wood chip delivery will be on a first come basis and dependent on where the crews are working. Efforts are made to evenly distribute the wood chips throughout the Township.
7. Weymouth Township reserves the right to discontinue this free service without prior notice and for any reason.
