

**WEYMOUTH TOWNSHIP COMMITTEE SPECIAL BUDGET WORKSHOP MEETING
MINUTES
MARCH 10, 2021 10:00 AM**

Pursuant to the Governor's issuance of Executive Order #107 this meeting is being held via conference call. Adequate notice of this meeting was advertised in the Press of Atlantic City on March 6, 2021 and duly posted on the Township Bulletin Board and the Township's website in accordance with Public Law 1975, Chapter 231 as required by law.

This Special Meeting of the Weymouth Township Committee was called to order by Committee Chairman, Kenneth Haeser. Due to the nature of this Work Shop setting and lack of public participation the opening ceremonies were curtailed.

Those present at this meeting were Township Committee Members Kenneth Haeser, C. Peter Keiffenheim, and Edward Norton as well as Chief Financial Officer Judson Moore, Auditor Fred Caltabiano of Bowman and Co., Township Clerk Dorothy-Jo Ayres and Superintendent of Public Works, Ronald C. Carroll.

The purpose of this Special Work Shop Session was to allow the Committee Members a final review of the proposed Municipal Budget and to have any remaining questions or concerns addressed prior to the Public Hearing on the Budget scheduled for March 17, 2021.

Mr. Caltabiano reported that the proposed Budget would represent no change in the tax levy for 2021.

The Township Committee reviewed every line item and considered if each should be adjusted. After more discussion, the three Committee Members agreed that the budget would remain unchanged from that which was proposed.

It was determined that the Budget should be introduced on March 17th and the Second Reading and Public Hearing would be scheduled for May 5, 2021.

There was no further business to come before this meeting and it was adjourned at 11:11 AM.
