This Special Meeting of the Weymouth Township Committee was called to order by Committee Chairman, Kenneth Haeser. Due to the nature of this Work Shop setting and lack of public participation the opening ceremonies were curtailed.

Those present at this meeting were Township Committee Members Kenneth Haeser, C. Peter Keiffenheim, and Edward Norton as well as Chief Financial Officer Judson Moore, Auditor Fred Caltabiano of Bowman and Co., Township Clerk Dorothy-Jo Ayres and Superintendent of Public Works, Ronald C. Carroll.

The purpose of this Special Work Shop Session was to allow the Committee Members a final review of the proposed Municipal Budget and to have any remaining questions or concerns addressed prior to the Public Hearing on the Budget scheduled for April 15, 2020.

Mr. Caltabiano that the proposed Budget would represent a 1.52% tax levy which comes out to an eighth of a penny. An average home in Weymouth Township (\$192,000 assessment) would see a \$16 increase for the year.

The Township Committee reviewed every line item and considered if each should be adjusted. After more discussion, the three Committee Members agreed that the budget would remain unchanged from that which was proposed.

It was determined that the Budget should be introduced on March 18th and the Second Reading and Public Hearing would be scheduled for April 15th.

There was no further business to come before this meeting and it was adjourned at 10:25 AM.
