Function: The Weymouth Township Municipal Utilities Authority (WTMUA) is a self-financed agency, appointed by Weymouth Township's Township Committee. The WTMUA oversees the operation and function of water and septic services provided by the Hamilton Township Municipal Utilities Authority to service recipients in Weymouth Township. The WTMUA:

- sets rates,
- approves applications for water and septic connections,
- maintains water and septic lines, plus fire-hydrants, and
- authorizes payment for water and septic services to the Hamilton Township Municipal Utilities Authority.

Composition: The WTMUA historically has been composed of owner-users of the water and septic services provided by the WTMUA. The WTMUA consists of:

PLANNING BOARD/ZONING BOARD OF ADJUSTMENT

Since 1975, when the Municipal Land Use Law, N.J.S.A. 40:55D-1, et. seq., was first implemented, land use boards have been vested with an ever increasing array of responsibilities. Boards are now directly responsible for practically all land use decisions, EXCEPT, when preempted by other agencies. The duties of the Planning Board can be summarized as being the board of "permitted activities!" As a member of the Planning Board you are considered a policy maker.

The duties of the Zoning Board of Adjustment deal with "non-permitted uses!" As a member of this board you are, a judge, although a quasi (to some degree)-judicial one.

Weymouth Township's form of government (Mayor-Council) allows for Seven (7) regular members on each board, with Two (2) additional members on each board as Alternates.

Members of the Planning Board are appointed by the Mayor.

Members to the Zoning Board of Adjustment are appointed by the entire Township Committee.
